

STUDENT SUPPORT

When you arrive in the UK, you will not be allowed to leave the place where you're staying for the first 14 days you're in the UK (known as 'self-isolating) unless you're arriving from an exempt country

If you are self isolating or you don't feel comfortable going to the supermarket, you can do your grocery shopping online and have it delivered to your accommodation.

Here's how:

- 1. Register for an account with Sainsburys using your email address by scanning the QR code
- 2. Browse for groceries and add the items you wish to buy to your shopping bag.
- 3. Once you have all the items you wish to buy in your basket, go to the checkout to select a delivery slot and make payment.

If you wish to open a UK bank account, you can complete your registration completely online with RBS and Natwest. Other banks are available, however if you choose to use another bank, you may be asked to complete part of the process in branch.
